MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 11th-154-2025

AN ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MUNICIPAL MEAT INSPECTION SERVICE (MMIS) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MOLAVE, PROVINCE OF ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR UNDER MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 11TH-33-2023 BY INCLUDING ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS ON THE GUIDELINES ON THE TRANSPORT OF MEAT UNDER SECTION 23 AND ON FEES UNDER SECTION 27.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Molave, Zamboanga del Sur, that:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE. The proposed amendments to the schedule of operations and fees for the Municipal Meat Inspection Service are necessary to better align with the current needs of our local businesses and the community. As our municipality continues to grow and evolve, we have seen an increase in demand for meat inspection services, both in terms of volume and the types of businesses seeking these services. Fixing the operating and delivery hours will allow us to better accommodate our clients while ensuring timely inspections and reducing delays in service. Additionally, the added fees are intended to reflect the rising costs of operation, including labor, equipment, and maintaining the high standards of food safety that our residents expect. By implementing these changes, we aim to provide more efficient services, while ensuring that we continue to uphold our commitment to public health and safety in our municipality.

SECTION 2. SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS. There shall be additional provisions under the following sections of Municipal Ordinance No. 11th-33-2023:

- SECTION 23. GUIDELINES OF THE TRANSPORT OF MEAT. X XXXX

The schedules of meat delivery to the market by authorized MLSH meat van shall be as follows:

Cattle meat 3:00 A.M.
Hog meat 4:00 A.M.

SECTION 27. <u>SERVICE FEES AND CHARGES</u>. The following fees and charges shall be imposed for services rendered by the LGU through the Municipal Meat Inspection Service for the information and guidance of all concerned.

MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE MEETING OF THE COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN (11TH MUNICIPAL COUNCIL UNDER THE LGC OF 1991) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MOLAVE, PROVINCE OF ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR HELD AT THE SB OFFICE, 3RD FLOOR, MUNICIPAL HALL ON MARCH 31, 2025 AT 10:01 A.M. PRESENT:

The committee meeting started at 10:01 in the morning.

The Chairman presented the following:

A. A letter from the mayor forwarding the letter request of Mr. Elmer Ollanas, Municipal Agriculture Officer, increasing rental fees for the Function Hall of Farmer's Training Center and designating fees for the newly received farm machineries and equipment as grant from the PHILMECH under RCEF Mechanization Program.

The Chairman emphasized that the Local Government Unit has received Farm Machineries and Equipment as a Grant from PHILMECH under the RCEF Mechanization Program, which requires full utilization to benefit rice farmers and the submission of periodic utilization reports.

He informed the body that the Municipal Agriculture Office, through its Municipal Agriculturist, Mr. Elmer M. Ollanas, has requested an increase in the rental for the Function Hall of the Farmers Training Center from \$3,000.00 per day to \$5,000.00 per day and outlined proposed rates for the use of farm machinery and equipment received as a grant from PHILMECH under the RCEF Mechanization Program.

Following the presentation, Mr. Ollanas explained the increase in function hall rental fees, citing recent upgrades designed to enhance comfort and functionality. The previous air conditioning system, consisting of two split-type units, proved insufficient for events exceeding 50-60 attendees. To address this, a larger, more powerful unit has been installed. This, along with a new backup solar-powered generator ensuring uninterrupted power, and an upgraded sound system, significantly improves the hall's

capabilities. The proposed rental fee increase directly reflects the costs of these improvements including the maintenance.

Hon. Jacosalem Perong, Jr. suggested designating an operator for the sound system and solar powered generator to prevent damage. Mr. Elmer Ollanas noted the said suggestion and clarified that the Municipal Engineer will maintain the generator.

Hon. Joel Geromo inquired about receipt issuance for rental payments. Mr. Ollanas confirmed that receipts are issued through the Municipal Treasurer's Office.

Regarding farm machinery and equipment, Mr. Elmer Ollanas reported that full utilization is crucial to benefit rice farmers, necessitating the submission of regular utilization reports. He explained that current underutilization stems from the LGU's lack of operators. The proposed rental rate covers only the equipment; operators and fuel are not included. He said that a MOA will be made with the association who will rent the farm machineries. He added that the Dipolo Farmers' Association was selected as the sole lessee of the 4WD farm tractor and harvester. The association will be responsible for fuel and operator costs, as the LGU does not have personnel to operate the machinery. He added that a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) shall be established between the selected farmer's association and the LGU outlining the rental terms for the farm machineries and equipment.

Mrs. Lucia Ejes asked who will shoulder the maintenance.

Mr. Elmer Ollanas clarified that the LGU will cover maintenance costs from the farm machinery's income. Mrs. Imelda Torrefranca confirmed the existence of a repair and maintenance budget. Mr. Ollanas explained that machinery income will be deposited into the general fund, allowing for future maintenance requests.

Mrs. Imelda Torrefranca stated that Imelda Torrefranca suggested using farm machinery income to fund a supplemental budget for their maintenance.hey can also have a supplemental budget to fund the farm machinery maintenance using its income.

Hon. Cornelio Salinas added that the MOA should explicitly stipulate that the association will designate a single, qualified operator responsible for operating all farm machinery and equipment to ensure their proper use and minimize the risk of damage. He further added that the MOA should also clearly state that the association will be responsible for all repair costs incurred due to damage caused by the negligence of the operator.

The body agreed to Hon. Cornelio R. Salinas.

Hon. Cornelio Salinas opined that the 4WD farm tractor could also be used for rice transport. The committee deliberated on the rate of 4WD Farm tractor as rice carrier, after discussion, the committee agreed on a transport rate of \$\mathbb{P}\$1,000.00 per hectare.

Hon. Salinas instructed Mr. Ollanas to monitor farm machinery usage.

Mr. Ollanas responded that they would check the association's logbook, noting its accuracy. He mentioned that the harvester's "Smart Assist" app, though not yet installed, would allow for more precise usage monitoring once activated. He confirmed that they had contacted the supplier to activate the app.

Hon. Salinas cautioned against sole reliance on the association's logbook, citing the potential for manipulation. He emphasized the need for close monitoring to ensure accurate tracking of farm machinery use.

Mr. Elmer Ollanas stated that he has assigned personnel to monitor the use of the farm machineries rented by the association. He then informed the body that he forgot to include in his proposal the rate of the rent of the mud boat, which is a package with the harvester.

The committee deliberated and set a rental rate of \$\mathbb{P}\$1,000.00 per hectare for the mud boat, with a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to detail the rental terms.

The Chairman then asked the pleasure of the body.

Hon. Desiderio L. Jabello moved to recommend for the enactment of an ordinance amending Section 4F.01 (Imposition of Fees), Article F (Farmers' Training Center and Agricultural Machineries) of Chapter IV (Municipal Charges) of Municipal Ordinance No. 11th-14-2022 (Local Revenue Code for Fees and Charges), which was duly seconded by Hon. Joel M. Geromo.

The Chairman asked for objection.

Nothing was heard, so, he proceeded to present the next topic.
