A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE 2ND SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (AIP) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MOLAVE, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR, PURSUANT TO MDC RESOLUTION NO. 10, S. 2026.

WHEREAS, Section 106 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, created the Municipal Development Council (MDC) as the primary planning and policy-making body responsible for formulating and recommending local development plans and investment programs to the Sangguniang Bayan for appropriate legislative action;

WHEREAS, in the exercise of its mandate, the Municipal Development Council, through MDC Resolution No. 10, Series of 2026, endorsed for approval the Second Supplemental Annual Investment Program (AIP) for Fiscal Year 2026, together with the Aligned Form and the Minutes of the Municipal Peace and Order Council Meeting, after determining that the proposed programs, projects, and activities are responsive to the Municipality's current development priorities and service delivery requirements;

WHEREAS, the proposed Second Supplemental Annual Investment Program provides funding for priority interventions in governance, public health, water supply, infrastructure development, local economic development, gender and development, peace and order, and other essential public services, with a total investment requirement of Twenty Million One Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand Twenty-Two Pesos and Forty-Seven Centavos (P20,133,022.47), to wit
